Regal Morchel

According to a press release, the present world record holder for lifetime milk production has been put down on May 5, 2010. Studach's Regal Morchel, a Rapture EI Regal daughter born on February 9, 1987, produced in her lifetime 197'000 kg of milk in 6994 days and 14 lactations.

Her milk components were 3.44%fat and 3.44% crude protein. This equals 434'310 pounds of milk, 14'930 pounds of fat and 14'921 pounds of protein, making her the world record holder for lifetime production of the breed.

Morchel spent her lifetime on the farm of the Studach family in Moerschwil, at a 10 minutes drive from the city of St. Gallen. She last calved on August 20, 2006, with a heifer calf by Bruget, and her last test on April 26, 2010 was 6.0 kg. Morchel goes back to Rapture EI Regal, from a dam sired by Johann Proud Matthew (W) with a lifetime production of 74398kg or 164019 pounds, then a cow sired by Darwin, a Beautician (A) son, and after that Original Braunvieh.
