## BROWN SWISS 2022/23 ON FARM CHALLENGE

It is time for another Brown Swiss On-Farm Challenge. The rules are quite simple.

All animals have to be at least **% breed** or better, in milk (with milk on at the time of judging), on a hard surface (not in the paddock), don't have to be clipped and are not to be on a halter.

All in-milk animals entered are automatically in the Best Udder competition.

This should make it possible for most to participate in this on farm challenge.

The judge is to be confirmed. Judging will be in Late November / December 2022. You will be notified of the date as soon as I have all entries. The entry fee is \$10 plus GST per animal. This is to cover costs for the judge and maybe have some leftover for the association.

This year we have a yearling class. This is limited to three (3) animals per farm and they must be at the same site as the in-milk animals.

We have again decided to open the show to people who have registered Brown Swiss animals and are thinking of joining the Association. **Entry fee is \$15 plus GST per animal.**
